Fee (2024)

- Regular Course
 - Application Fee : 50,000 KRW
[※Application fee will not be refunded]
 - Tuition Fee : 1,250,000 KRW / per semester
※ insurance fee, 4 textbooks fee and cultural experience fee (once) are included
- Notice in common
International Students must pay at least 2 semesters tuition in advance.
(Some of the country need to pay 4 semesters tuition in advance.)

Application Process(from abroad)

1. Send the application with other required documents via post
2. Review documents and notify screening results (Myongji College)
※ Will be notify after 3 weeks from the registration deadline.
3. Make the payment
4. [Myongji College] Sends out Certificate of Admissions
5. Visit the Korean Embassy located in their home country to apply for visa

Additional documents for 4 semesters registration mandatory country

⑥ Copy of Identification (Both Parents)	Must note English name
⑦ Official document indicating parent-child relationship between the applicant and his/her parents (Original/hard file)	Must note English name
⑧ Certificate of employment and certificate of Income(Parents') (Original/hard file)	
⑨ Original Korean identity certificate and employment certificate (notarized by the office of Korea lawyer)(Original/hard file)	if applicable

※ Documents not completed in Korean, English or Chinese must be accompanied by notarized Korean or English translations.

※ Documents submitted will NOT be returned to the applicants regardless of admission results.

Guide for Certificate of Graduation

- ① Documents from a member nation of "Apostilled Treaty" may be apostilled from proper
- ② The diplomas issued by high schools and university must be certified at the Korean Embassy for "Consul Confirmation". Korean Embassy Consul Confirmation is not acceptable for those whose country signed up for Apostille.
- ③ Chinese – Educational Proficiency Certification Report for Final School Graduation Certificate by Chinese Ministry of Education(<http://www.chsi.com.cn> or <http://www.cdgd.edu.cn>) submission. (In the case of middle school/vocational high school graduation, province education office certification +consulate certification).
